FINANCIAL REPORT

April was an improvement over February and March but still resulted in a small shortfall of \$5,907.

April highlights:

- April income: \$127,704 vs. budget \$119,853, <u>\$7,851 higher than budget</u>
- April expense: \$133,611 vs. budget \$136,913, <u>\$3,302 under budget.</u> Shortfall \$5,907

Year-to-Date:

- Income YTD: \$1,183,233 vs. budget \$1,217,229. <u>FYTD income shortfall is</u> <u>\$33,996</u>
- Expenses YTD: \$1,098,195 vs. budget \$1,165,076. This is the result of the timing of many expenses (e.g., missions, operating cost associated with the new building, etc.).
- Annual Budget: \$1,462,618. Average monthly income for May and June needs to be \$140k to meet budget income.
